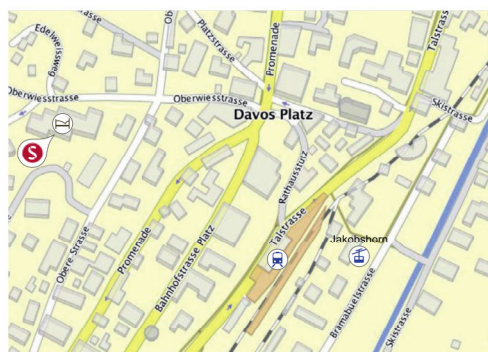

How to get here

By rail

→ Basel/Berne – Zurich – Landquart – Davos Platz: direct connections with IR/IC/EC/TGV from Basel, Zurich, St. Gallen, Hamburg, Brussels and Paris (only on Saturday in winter) to Landquart. Change into the RegioExpress train as far as the final station Davos Platz.

→ Lugano – Bellinzona – Thusis – Filisur – Davos Platz

We will gladly collect you from the railway station if you wish. Just let us know your time of arrival.

By car

→ from Berne/Basel – Zurich: on the motorway A1/A3-A13 as far as the exit "Landquart". Follow the well-made regional road for 45 km to Davos Platz. Drive along the main street or "Promenade" (which is one-way) as far as Rätia Centre, then turn right after the Vögele shoe shop (signposted to Sunstar Hotels). Take the next road on the left and then turn into the park on the right.

→ from Lugano – Bellinzona – San Bernardino: on the motorway A13 as far as the exit "Thusis-Süd". Follow the regional road 45 km passing Tiefencastel and Alvaneu to Davos Platz. Shortly after the entrance into the resort at the "Haus Bernina" make your left turn into "Obere Strasse", next road left and enter to the park.
